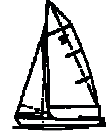

Notice of race

1. RULES

- 1.1. The racing will be governed by the rules as defined in 'The Racing Rules of Sailing 2009 - 2012 (RRS), the Prescriptions of the RYA, the Signet Class Rules, this NOR and the UYC Sailing Instructions (2009 - 2012) in ascending order.
- 1.2. The organising authority will be UYC in conjunction with the Signet Class Owners Association.
- 1.3. Competitors should note that UYC operate the RYA Racing Charter and they will be expected to sail in compliance with the Charter.
- 1.4. The Exoneration Penalty [and the Advisory Hearing and Arbitration procedures] of the RYA Rules Disputes Procedure will be available.

2. ADVERTISING

- 2.1. Unrestricted Category C advertising is allowed under Appendix 1 of the ISAF Advertising Code.

3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1. The regatta is open to any boat with a Portsmouth Yardstick Rating
- 3.2. A class measurement certificate may be required to be produced
- 3.3. Eligible boats may enter by completing the attached Entry Form and sending it, with the required fee, to the UYC Competition Secretary postmarked no later than two weeks prior to the start of the event.
- 3.4. Eligible competitors will be required to meet the following criteria: willing to become temporary UYC members and capable of having a laugh
- 3.5. Late entries will be accepted, if presented with the required fee, at Registration.
- 3.6. Entries will be limited to 300 boats.
- 3.7. Competitors, including support teams, coaches, instructors, rescue crews and accompanying friends and families etc, shall consider themselves visitors / temporary members of UYC for the duration of the event.
- 3.8. Anyone who helped with rescue duties or Race officer duties throughout the week will be granted average points after discards.

Notes for Signet class attendees:

- Both the UYC entry form AND the Signet class entry form on page 1 are required. Please complete both forms and send them to Richard Cannon and the UYC form will be given to the club on your behalf.
- Please try to meet the 2 week deadline if possible (and note the £5 saving if entering before the 15th of July).
- Item 3.8 only applies to the regatta scoring events and not the Signet Class Championship race scoring.
- Please complete the camping section of the form to help with site planning but pay the appropriate fee on arrival at the club instead of including it with your entry fee.
- There is a £30 charge for families attending the regatta but not sailing. If this applies to you please complete only the UYC form and forward this with the fee to Richard Cannon and this will be passed to the club on your behalf.
